

Detachable Bookmark Tutorial

This tutorial will provide you with instructions to create a basic detachable bookmark card...not this particular card.

Cut a piece of card stock to 5 ½ x 10 ¼ inches.

With the long side of the card stock (10 ¼") horizontally in your paper trimmer, score at 4 ¼" from the left edge and perforate at 2 ¼" from the right edge.

If you don't have a perforating blade to use at the 2 ¼" edge of the bookmark, you can use a sewing machine without thread and create a stitch line as your perforation.

The size of the book mark can be adjusted if need be.

For example, if you have Stampin' Up's Scalloped Tag Topper punch, you could use that to shape the top of the bookmark, but you'd need to reduce the size of the bookmark to 2" to fit into the punch. You'd have to cut down that perforated/stitched line to the point where you can insert it into the punch.

Any corner punch can be used on the book mark, you just have to adjust your cut on the perforated line to accommodate the punch. Or you could take a simpler path and cut down just enough to use a corner rounder on each end of the bookmark and just use a circle punch to create the hole in the center.



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Detachable Bookmark

Cut card stock to 5 1/2" x 10 1/4". Score at 4 1/4" from left side. Perforate at 2 1/2" from right side
