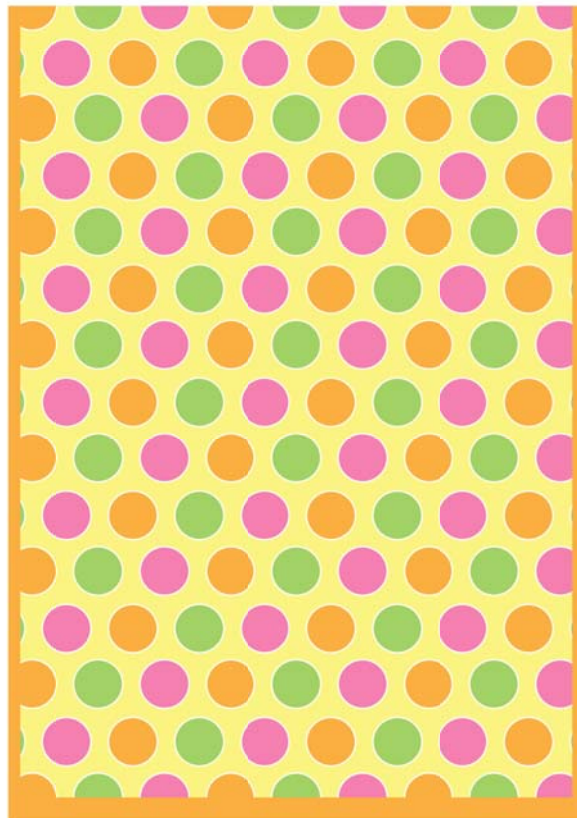
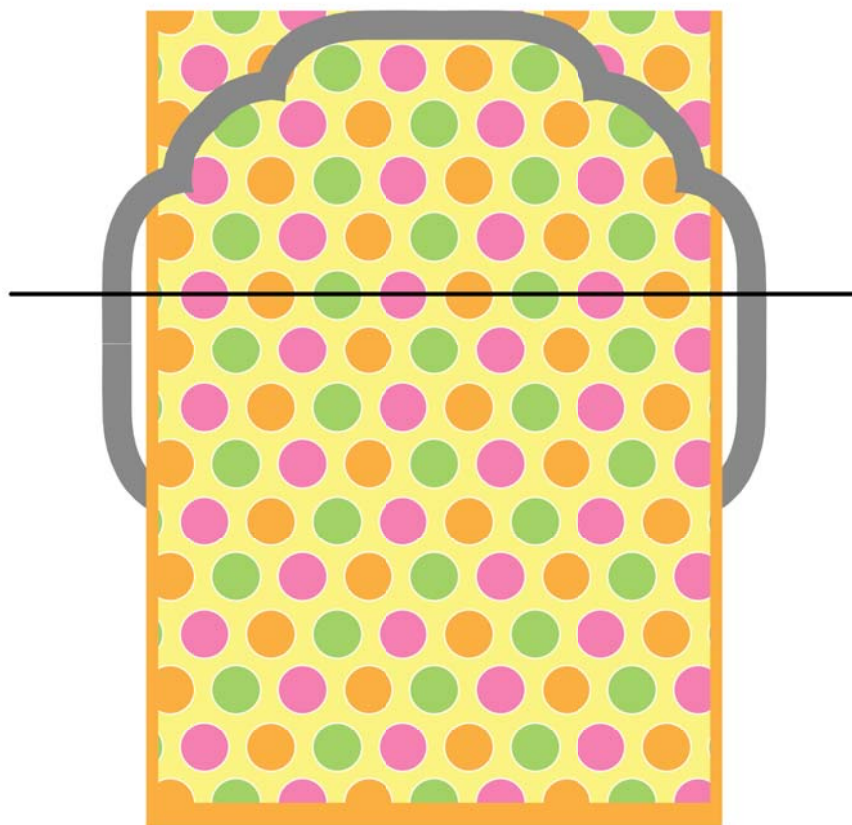


Hand Santa-tizer Tutorial

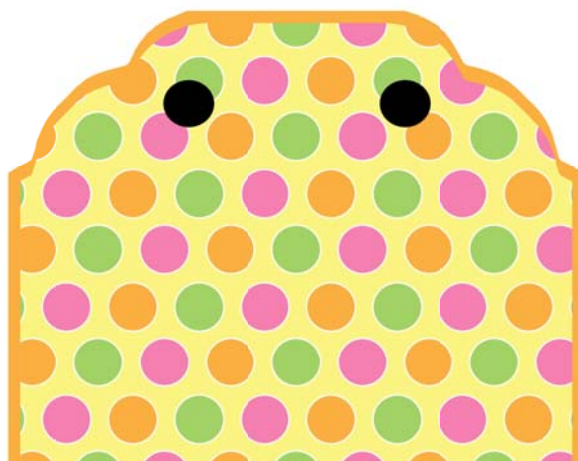
1. Cut the base to $9 \frac{7}{8}$ " x 3". You can adjust the height to accommodate your sanitizer, but don't adjust the width or the insert will no longer fit. Don't worry about the two circles; they are just a placement guide for later.
2. Using the template as a guide, score the base at $4 \frac{1}{4}$ ", $4 \frac{15}{16}$ " and $5 \frac{5}{8}$ "
3. Cut two pieces of patterned paper (or four if you want to decorate the inside as well) to $4 \frac{1}{8}$ " x $2 \frac{7}{8}$ "
4. Fold the base on the $4 \frac{15}{16}$ " score. Now attach the patterned paper to each side with removable adhesive. Align at the top and centered, side to side.



5. You can leave the edge plain if you wish, but this tutorial will presume you want to cut a decorative edge. Select a die to use on the top; it needs to be wide enough for the base to slide through it. Slide all layers under the top of the die, as shown. Run the base through your die cut machine up to the line shown. If you go beyond it, it will crease the base.



6. Once you've die cut the edge, center the patterned paper on the base (side to side and between the top and first score mark, leaving the area between the two outer score lines plain). Once the patterned paper is attached, fold the base in half again and make two holes as shown through all layers for the ribbon closure.

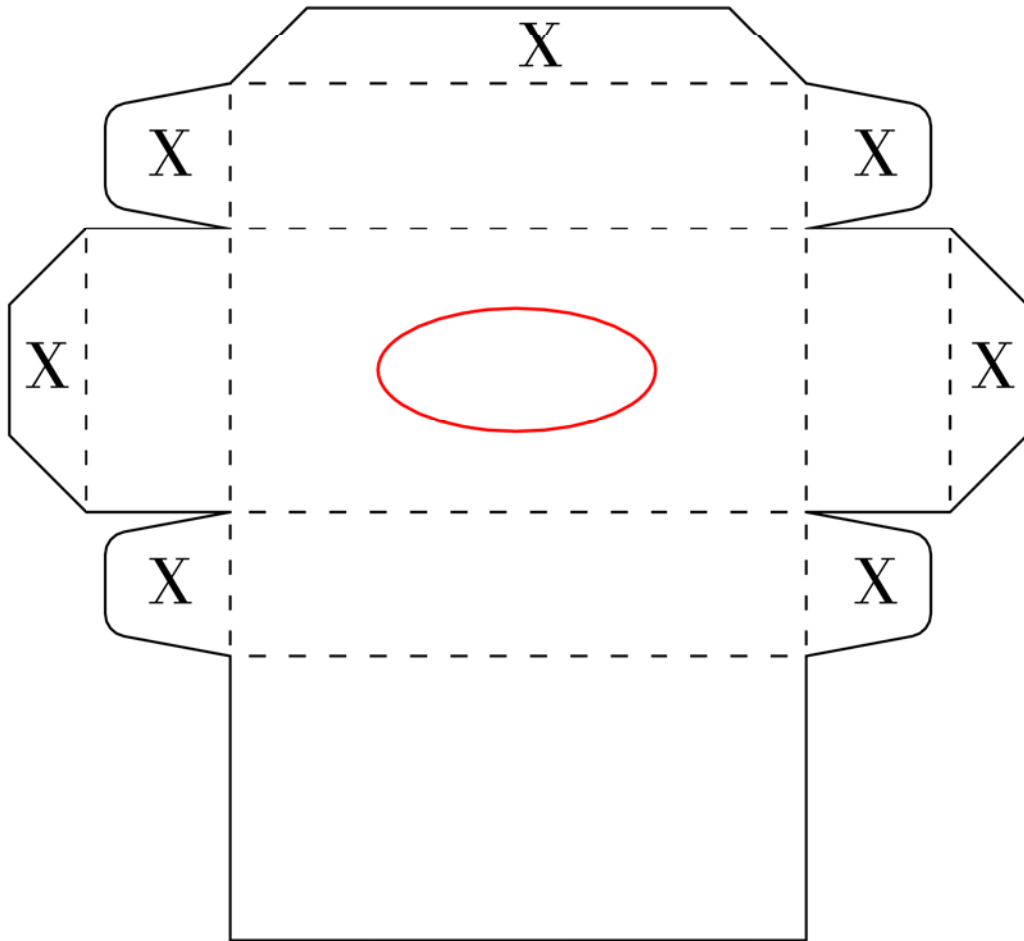


7. Cut the insert from the template provided and score on the dotted lines. Fold on score lines and burnish with a bone folder.

8. As all personal-size sanitizers are different shapes and sizes, trace the bottle of the sanitizer you're using in the center section indicated with an oval. Cut out the traced area.

9. Place liquid adhesive or double sided tape on the areas marked with an X.

10. Fold into a box and attach the flaps to the bottom panel. When you've formed the box, apply liquid adhesive or double sided tape to the bottom and attach to the inside center of the base.



11. Decorate the inside as desired. Pick your favorite ribbon and run it through the holes in the top and there you have it! Enjoy!

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
