

## Petal Potpourri Acetate Card Tutorial

As a note card or for a special occasion, this card is “clearly” a winner.

### Supplies Used:

#### Stamp Set(s), Ink and Coloring Accessories:

Petal Potpourri and Elements of Style by Stampin' Up  
Tangerine Tango Stamp Pad by Stampin' Up  
Pumpkin Pie Blendabilities Assortment by Stampin' Up  
Staz-On White Ink & Refill

#### Card Stock (8 ½” 11” unless otherwise specified)

Crisp Cantaloupe, Daffodil Delight and Whisper White by Stampin' Up

#### Patterned Paper:

Watercolor Wonder Digital by Stampin' Up

#### Other Paper Products:

Acetate

Medium Whisper White Envelopes

#### Embossing & Glitter

Glitter-Orange

#### Punches:

Flower Medallion by Stampin' Up

#### Other Accessories:

Stampin' Trimmer

Bone Folder

Mono Permanent Adhesive by Tombow

Stampin' Dimensionals by Stampin' Up

Mini Glue Dots by Glue Dots

### Assembly Instructions:

1. Cut the Window Sheet to 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; score at 4 1/4", fold and burnish with a Bone Folder. Note: Burnish several times to make a crisp fold.
2. Stamp the front (and back if you wish) of the card randomly with the Elements of Style stamp and Staz-On White Ink. Set aside and allow to dry.
3. Stamp the Petal Potpourri flower in Tangerine Tango on Daffodil Delight and punch with Flower Medallion. Also cut a panel of Daffodil Delight as per the template provided.
4. Stamp the Petal Potpourri flower in Tangerine Tango twice on Crisp Cantaloupe with punch with Flower Medallion. Also cut a panel of Crisp Cantaloupe as per the template provided.
5. Cut the Whisper White card stock as per the template provided.
6. Cut the Watercolor Wonder Patterned Paper as per the template provided.
7. Place a piece of scrap Acetate over the flowers and make three circles the size of the center of the flower with Glossy Accents. Drizzle Orange Glitter over the top of the circles. Set aside and allow to dry. Once dry, color with the medium color in the Pumpkin Pie Blendabilities collection.
8. Place template #1 behind the folded card, aligned to all sides. Open the card and attach the Whisper White panel to the inside of the card, lined up to the template, with Mono Permanent Adhesive.
9. Now turn the card over and apply Mono Permanent Adhesive directly to the Window Sheet behind the Whisper White panel, keeping it inside the Whisper White area.
10. Turn your card to the front again, center the Daffodil Delight panel on the Whisper White panel and attach on the back of the card with Mono Permanent Adhesive.
11. Place template #2 inside the card, facing up. Attach the Watercolor Wonder Patterned Paper panel on the front of the card, lined up to the template, with Mono Permanent Adhesive.
12. Open the card and apply Mono Permanent Adhesive directly to the Window Sheet behind the Patterned Paper panel, keeping it inside the Patterned Paper area.
13. Center the Crisp Cantaloupe panel behind the Patterned Paper panel and attach to the inside front with Mono Permanent Adhesive.
14. Attach the two Crisp Cantaloupe flowers to the card front with Mono Permanent Adhesive. Line the tops and sides up with the Daffodil Delight panel BUT make sure your adhesive does not extend past the edges of the Crisp Cantaloupe or you'll see the adhesive through the window sheet.
15. Attach the Daffodil Delight flower with Dimensionals just in the center of the flower. Line it up to

the left edge of the card and centered between the two Crisp Cantaloupe flowers.

16. Apply several TINY dots of Glossy Accents to the center of each flower and place the Glossy Accents flower center over each flower and set aside to dry.
17. Decorate your envelope as desired.
18. Enjoy your card!

**Want to take this card up a notch? Try one of these ideas:**

- Stamp the Petal Potpourri in Tangerine Tango on the Whisper White panel to bring the design inside.
- Create a card for a specific event rather than a blank note card by using your favorite stamp set and Tangerine Tango Ink.
- Use decorative edge punches on your card stock panels. Remember to cut the pieces larger to accommodate the amount removed by the punch.
- Dry emboss the card stock panels for more dimension. The Petals-A-Plenty embossing folder by Stampin' Up would be a great choice.
- Or emboss the Acetate after the ink dries.

**Class tips with this project:**


- You can speed up the drying time of the Staz-On White Ink with a blow dryer or Heat Gun. If using a heat gun, don't allow the heat source to get too close to the Acetate or leave it in one spot too long or the Acetate will warp,
- Don't overlook the possibilities of Glossy Accents...check out the list of things you can do with it in the Hints & Tips section.
- Ensuring perfect placement of card stock panels by using templates.

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
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# Petal Potpourri Template 1

Cut to 4 1/2" x 3 1/4"

## Petal Potpourri Template 2

Daffodil Delight  
Cut to 5" x 3 3/4"

Crisp Cantaloupe  
Cut to 4" x 2 3/4"
